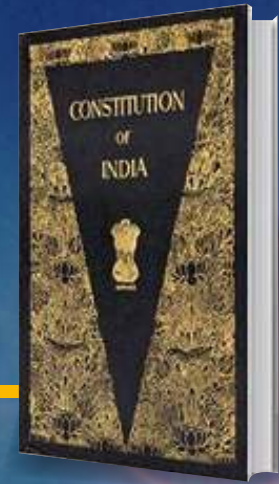

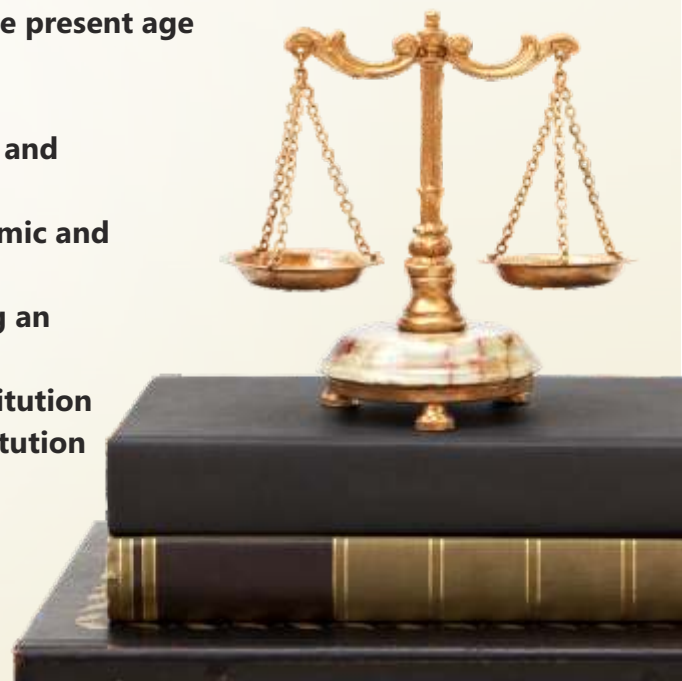
- **To review the progress of research in Philosophy from time to time**

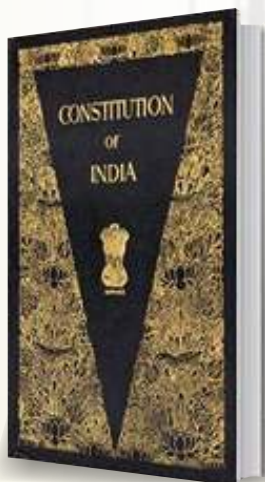
