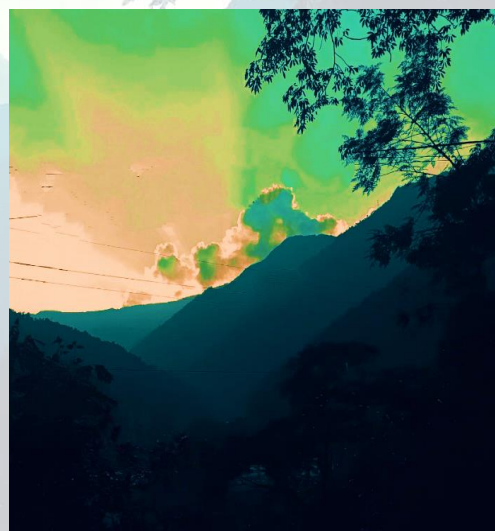
Greening Intellectual Property for the Protection of Environment: Renditions and Prospects

The book is designed to invite deliberations on the role of Intellectual Property Rights in the protection of the environment. Protection of environment is oftentimes parsed as sustainable development from a constricted and confined viewpoint of development. The historical tensions between the industrialized North and the underdeveloped South are reflected in the topography of the various regimes within the master framework of International Law.

The design of the book is to uncover the restricted meaning of the protection of environment as well the broad meaning of protection which castigates the emphasis upon development and treats it as situated within the IP regime. The book is intended to explore the idea in detail from a variety of viewpoints. The book seeks to delineate the contours of the topography of the regime of intellectual property rights that impinges upon the regime of environmental law through juxtapositioning the two regimes parallel to each other.

The book will explore the issues related to green intellectual property, technological transfer, climate change, sustainable development, polluter pays principles, emerging liability, trans-boundary pollution, protection of biodiversity, carbon trading etc.

The book invites original and unpublished submissions from academicians, practitioners and other legal professionals, representatives of governmental and non-governmental organizations, research scholars, and students etc. on the broad themes mentioned below.

Submission Guidelines:

- ⌘ Original and unpublished research papers are invited on aforementioned themes.
- ⌘ Co-authorship is allowed up to two authors per submission.
- ⌘ First page of your book chapter should contain the title of the book chapter, the name, designation, affiliation, institution if any, and complete postal address.
- ⌘ The author should submit a declaration of originality of the manuscript on the first page as **“The submission is our/my original research work and has never been published earlier nor has been submitted elsewhere for publication”**.
- ⌘ The book chapter should be in a 1.5 spacing, in “Times New Roman” font with 12 points throughout.
- ⌘ Authors need to submit their papers in the following manners:
 - ❖ Title of the paper
 - ❖ Author/ Author's name, designation, institution, email, mobile No
 - ❖ Abstract (Between 200-250 words)
 - ❖ Keywords
 - ❖ Introduction
 - ❖ Body of paper
 - ❖ Conclusion References/ Bibliography
- ⌘ The title should be in bold Times New Roman with font size 14 point and captions and sub-captions should be in bold with font size 12 point throughout the paper.
- ⌘ Article should be written in English only.
- ⌘ All the Tables are to be legible and properly justified within the template.
- ⌘ The book chapter should be prepared in accordance with a definite research methodology and consist of suggestions and conclusions.
- ⌘ The contributor (s) must ensure the provision of non-plagiarized content of their respective book chapter. The plagiarism report, if more than 10%, will be a ground for complete rejection of the paper. The author (s) of the paper shall be held personally liable for any plagiarism violations.
- ⌘ The APA (6th edition) references style must be followed.
- ⌘ The contributors will be informed about the acceptance of their paper via email only after the review of the paper by the members of the editorial board.

⌘ The editors shall not be providing hard copies of the book to the contributors. Interested authors may purchase the copy of the book from the publisher.
