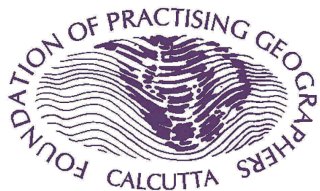

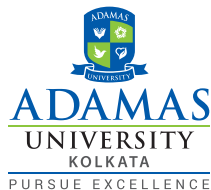

The title should be in bold with font size of 14 followed by author(s) name(s) in the next line, and affiliation in the subsequent line(s) as central alignment along with the email ID of the authors. The name of the presenting author should be underlined.

Body : Times New Roman 11 (Word Limit 250), Single spacing

Key Words: Maximum 5

Selected papers (full length article) will be published in an edited book volume with ISBN number by the Foundation of Practicing Geographers Publishing House, Kolkata after peer reviewing by the editorial committee without any publication fees.
